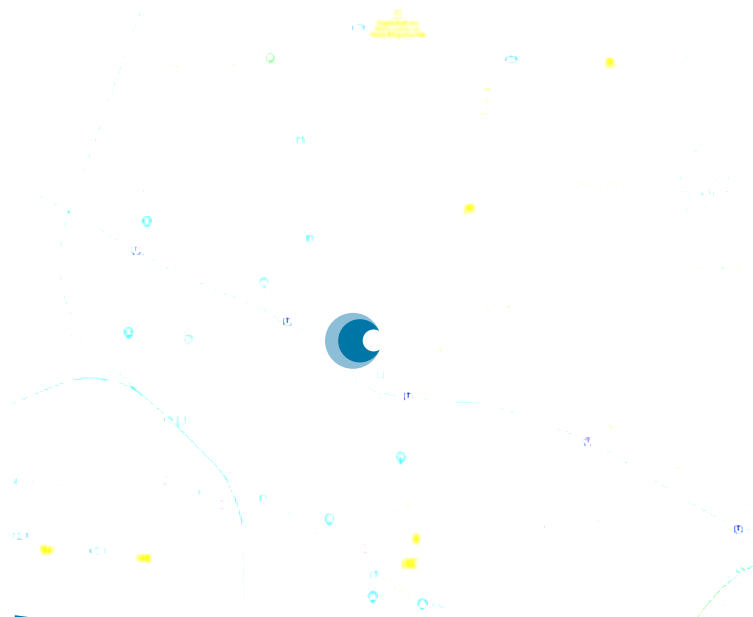

Prof. Stefan Georg Kissler

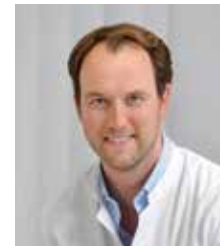
